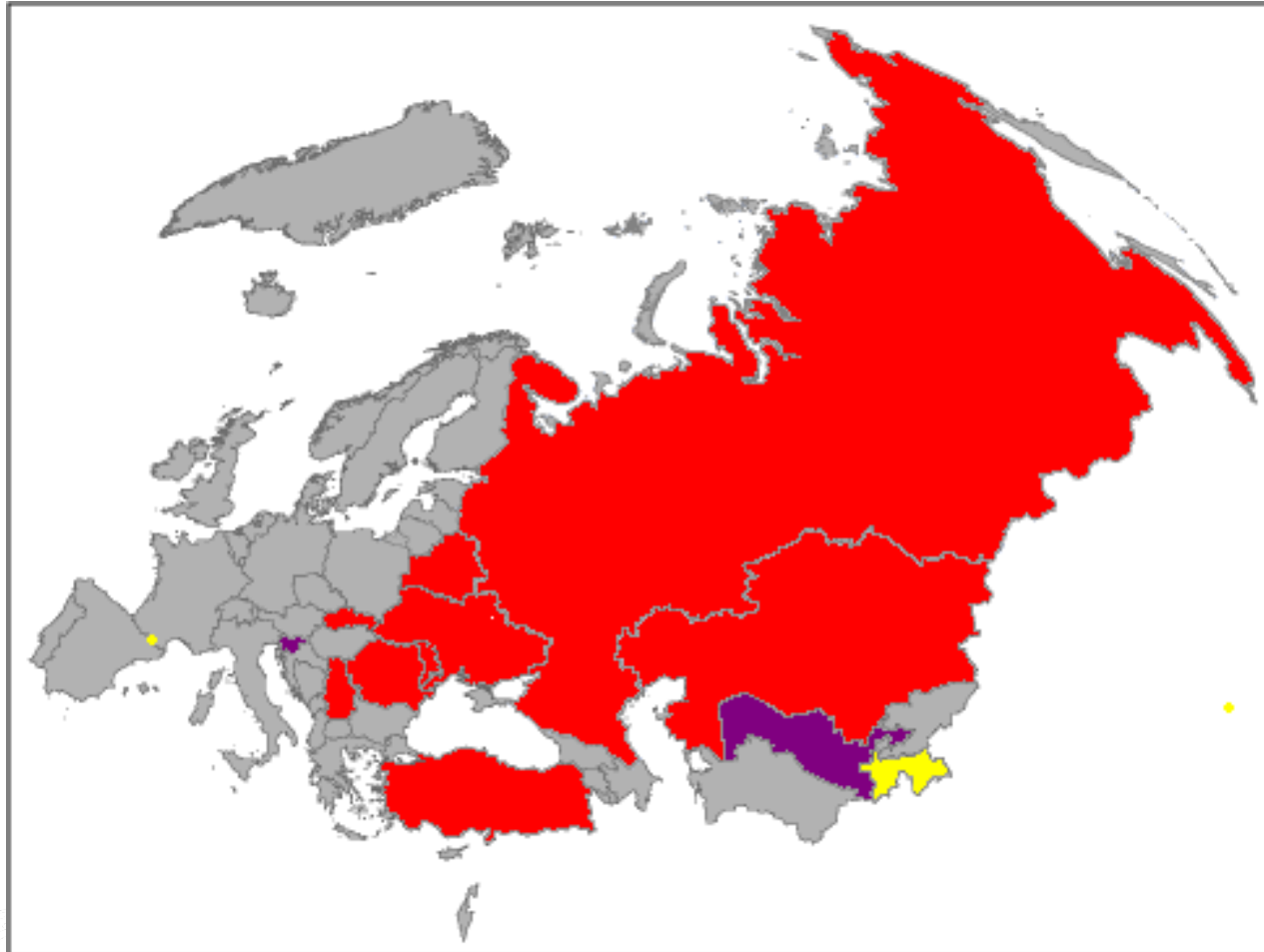

# Why is PHC so important?



- Lower hospitalisation
- Less use of specialist and emergency care
- Increased patient satisfaction
- Less risk of overtreatment
- Close to home
- More efficient use of resources

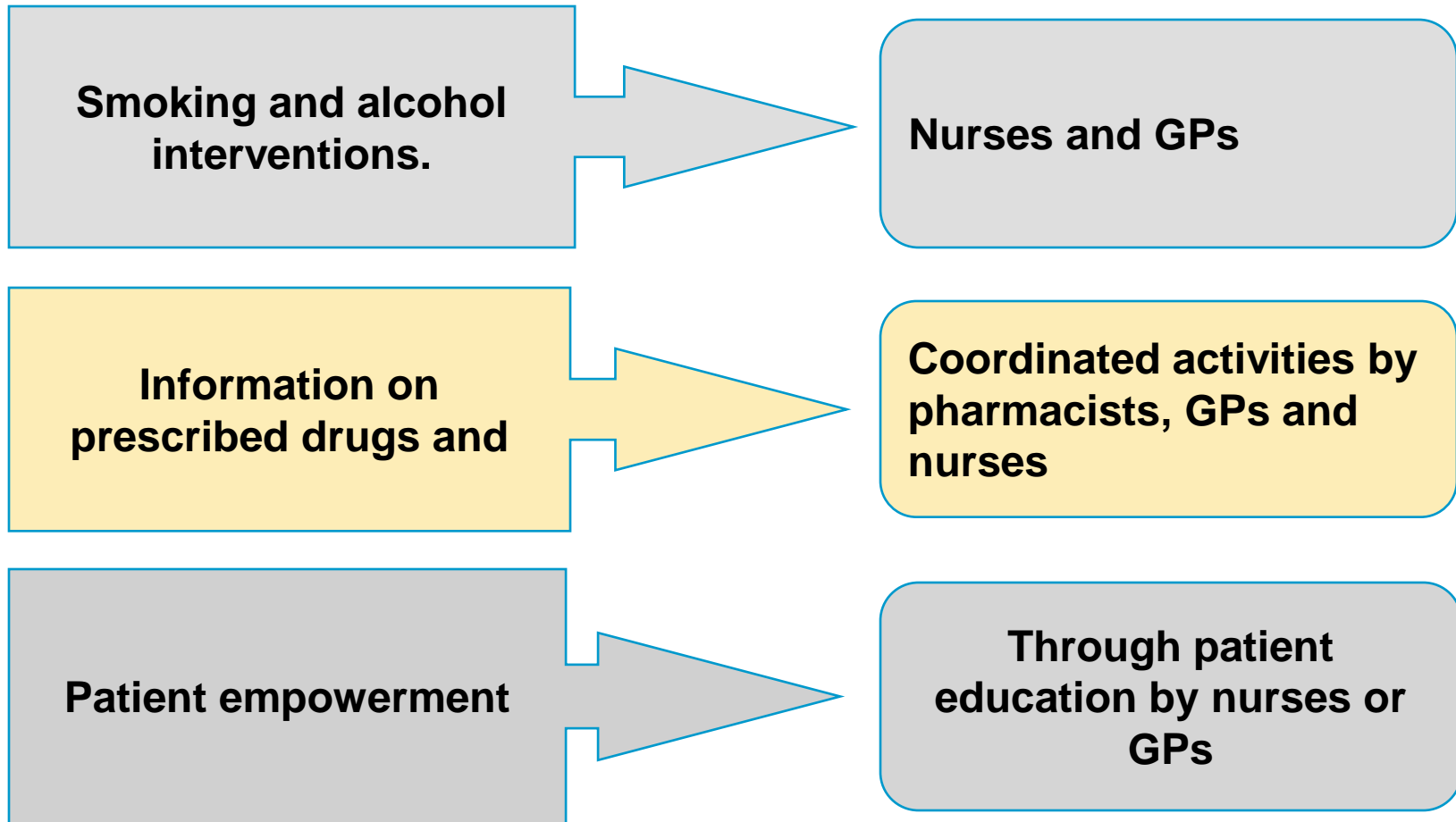

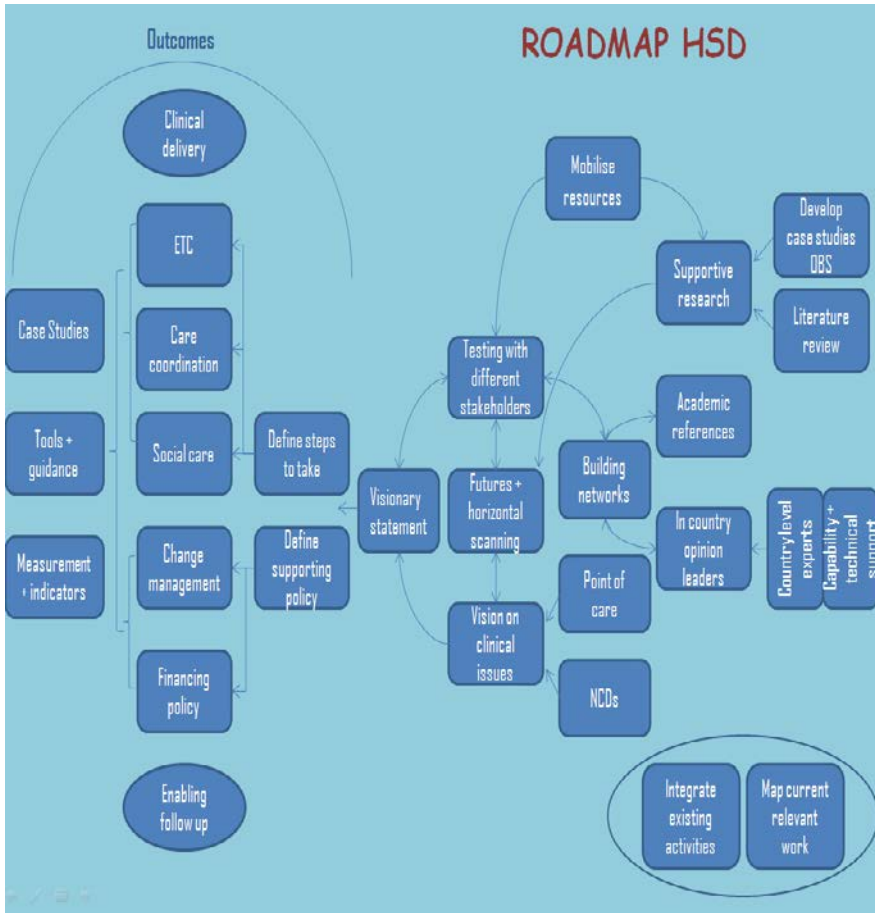
